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Unit 1 Product Overview


This product is based on TCP/IP protocol, works as a management center to manage the indoor monitors of residents and the outdoor stations of all the entrance of the community.

- 10.1 inch capacitive touch screen
- Can call indoor monitors and other guard units
- Can receive calls from indoor monitor, outdoor stations and other guard units
- Synchronously response to the alarming signal from the indoor monitor
- Record alarm information
- Remote unlock function, can unlock the outdoor stations/gate stations
- Monitor the Outdoor Stations, Gate Stations and IP Cameras
- Support emergency unlocking: unlock all outdoor stations with one key (1 hour)





3.1 Basic Functions



Call and Talk

Click the icon , and then select indoor monitor or guard unit, then input the number

Call Log


Click the icon to check call records between the management center and resident/visitors.

Alarm Log



to call the resident or another guard unit.

Card Management

,and then select a outdoor station/gate station or IP camera (if the

system has). Input device number to monitor a door station or a gate station, or the cover area of a IP camera.

Emergency Unlocking

Click the icon




to unlock all outdoor stations and gate stations in the community in

3.2 Call Out

Click CALL icon and choose the guard unit or indoor station to call.

Select device type as Indoor Station, input the building number + unit number + room number, then click to call


Call Guard Unit

station.


3.3 Call Log

Call Log Page


You can check call log between the guard unit and resident/visitors. Administrator/guard can call back to residents, also can check,/ delete the call records.

3.4 Monitoring

• Click manually to capture pictures when monitoring. The picture will be saved and can find in CALL LOG.



3.5 Identity Verification

1) Click the icon




to enter the interface.




System Setting Interface

be synchronized with the system time of PC automatically.


4.2 Diverting


- 1) Set to turn call forwarding on or off;

on the main interface \implies Ringtone, enter the ringtone setting interface.




Ringtone Setting Interface

Select the ringtone for each device calling


Note: The other ringtone refer to the incoming call of indoor monitor, villa outdoor station and guard unit.

interface.




Language Setting Interface

Click on the main interface ⇒ Display ,enter the display setting interface.




Display Setting Interface


Click on the main interface ⇒ Configuration enter password to Configuration setting interface

Click the Device No. Setting to edit the local number (the number range is 1-32).




Device No.Setting Interface

Factory Reset


Click Factory Reset \implies OK, system restore to factory setting.
